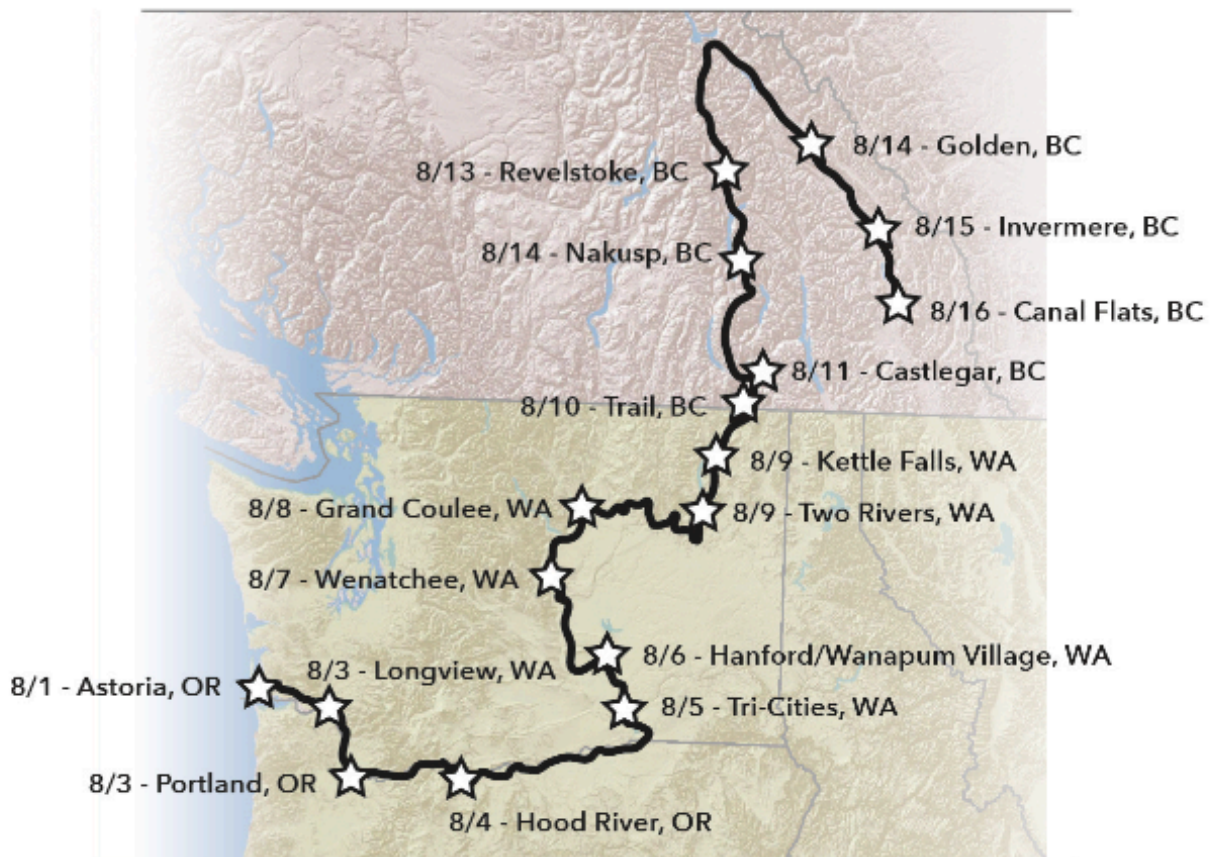


COLUMBIA RIVER MULTI-FAITH PRAYER VIGILS
